Directions to Jenkins Millview Trace

-The property is accessed from Highway 298 (Lillian Highway).

-The entrance road is 1.6 miles from the intersection of Lillian Highway and US Hwy 98, and 1.8 miles from the intersection of Lillian Highway and Blue Angel Parkway.

-The entrance road is directly across the street from 10138 Lillian Highway. Follow the Forest Stewardship Tour signs.
