This is a Survey Specialist 1 (Junior Crew Chief/ Instrument) position primarily supporting all field surveying activities; mostly under senior (Crew Chief) supervision, also independently as a Junior Crew Chief with minimum supervision.

Experienced Specialist Survey Instrument Technician that supports, directs and supervises activities of a survey crew and reviews work for accuracy and sufficiency. Operates survey-related instruments, such as a total-station, Hydrographic fathometer, levels, GPS units and Drone-Unmanned Aerial Systems. Records legible field notes, performs field inspections and prepares status reports documenting consultant progress. Provides quality control and quality assurance for field surveys and deliverables.
